

Travel Documents for Children (under 16 years of age)

Who can apply:

- Protected Persons
- Convention Refugees

You may apply for a travel document for a child (under the age of 16) if you are 1 of the following:

- One of the child's parents with proof of parentage (birth certificate)
- If separated or divorced, the custodial parent with all the necessary legal documents
- The child's legal guardian with proof of legal guardianship

Required pieces of personal identification (ID's) information including:

- Passport/travel document in the child's name
- PR Card (if applicable)
- Identity cards (driver's license, health card, Ontario photo card)
- Notice of Decision
- Refugee Protection Claimant Document
- Adoption, separation, or divorce papers
- proof of parentage or proof of legal guardianship (if applicable)
- 2 passport photos
- Guarantor

Additional Information:

- Parents' or legal guardians' information (name, surname, address, telephone, email)
- A receipt of your payment
- Travel documents for children (under 16 years of age)
